- 1. All Matches are open to NRA full members only and will be fired under NRA rules, unless stated otherwise.
- 2. Only ammunition as approved by NRA to be used. Competitors to supply their own.
- 3. Entry Fee is Honours only of \$40 all grades (inc NRA levies)
- 4. All Matches are 10 counting shots with 2 optional sighters.
- 5. Grading is based on latest NRA grading list. Shooters may enter in a higher grade.
- 6. In the event of the shoot being not attended, entries will be refunded.
- 7. Time Limit of 14 mins at 300 yards and 15 mins at 500 and 600 yards (10 shots), 21 mins (15 shots) 600 yards per shooter.
- 8. Number of prizes and badges to be presented will be at the discretion of the organising committee.
- 9. For the purposes of the team shoot the shooters club is the one that they are affiliated to NRA through.
- 10. Tyro is defined as per the NRA definition.
- 11. All disputes will be referred to the range committee.
- 12. Electronic targets will be used on both days.
- 13. "Super Centres" are now installed. All F Classes will be scored as 60.10 maximum, TR remain at 50.10.
- 14. Make sure you clearly mark your card as TR, FTR, FTR Classic, F/O or FPR. Scorers and check scorers please convert scores as necessary.
